# Registration

Please remember that **July 31st** is the final date for **online registration**. After this date, it will only be possible to register in person, with the fee indicated in the previous announcement. To facilitate the organization of the conference, we recommend you to register by the deadline to facilitate organization.

For the first time, the **Organizing Committee** will offer a buffet light lunch for September 9th, 10th, and 12th. # Instructions for Oral and Poster Presentations

## **Oral Presentations**

## Duration:

- *Keynote presentations:* 50 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes for questions and room change (total 55 minutes).
- **Oral presentations** (including symposia): 12 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes for Q&A + 3 minutes for room change (total 20 minutes).

**Language:** The congress is **bilingual** (Italian/English). If the oral presentation is in Italian, the slides must be in English, and vice versa. For foreign speakers who will present in English, it is recommended to prepare slides in Italian; the organization is available to support slide translation.

**Format:** Please save presentations in **PDF format**. .odp and .pptx formats are also supported, but a PDF version is required.





**Logo:** Please include the conference logo on the cover slide. Logos are available at the following link: [https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/1eEATRr8KiM-kSp0Mpf9qvv4wUf8Sgpgf?usp=sharing].

**Recommendations:** Use simple fonts (e.g., Calibri, Arial, Times New Roman), avoid complex animations, and embed video/audio directly into the presentation.

*Submission:* Please send your PDF presentations by *August 20th, 2025*, to the following email address: contributiXXIICIO@gmail.com. The email subject line must include: first name, last name, contribution type (oral or speed talk). The attached file must be saved with the following naming convention: Lastname\_Firstname\_ContributionTitle.

#### Posters

Format: The poster format is 70x100 cm, with a Vertical orientation.

*Content: Include only essential information, prioritizing results and discussion. Use images, graphs, and infographics over long texts.* 

*Language:* The congress is *bilingual*. The poster must include the English abstract submitted on the platform, while the rest of the content can be in Italian or English, as desired. The poster title must be in English.

**Placement:** Poster rooms are located within the conference complex. Posters can be put up by participants starting from September 8th at 3:00 PM. Fixing materials will be provided by the organization. Posters will be displayed in alphabetical order (by author's name), numbered, and placed on the corresponding panel. They can only be collected at the end of the conference.

*Submission:* Unlike oral contributions and speed talks, it is not necessary to send a PDF or PPT of the poster to the organizers.

**Poster Printing and Display Service:** To use the printing service and find your poster already affixed to the panel, simply send the PDF file of your poster by **August 10th** to **Grafiche Thermostyle srls**. Send the PDF to the email address: simonevergari6@gmail.com, specifying in the subject line: "Stampa Poster convegno di Ornitologia". To ensure receipt, please confirm the PDF submission by messaging 328 734 3675. The collection and display of the printed poster will be handled by the organizing committee. The printing cost is €5. Detailed payment instructions (via bank transfer, card, or PayPal) will be provided directly by Grafiche Thermostyle srls via email.

## Speed Talk:

Please note that even those selected to participate in the **Speed Talk Poster** session must print their poster during the conference, using the methods outlined above. Furthermore, presenters must prepare **ONE SINGLE slide** in PDF or PPT format, related to the poster's content, which will be projected during the "Speed Talk Poster" session. It is advisable to avoid small fonts and captions that are difficult to read from a distance, favoring a graphic layout that promotes understanding, leaning towards infographics (e.g., graphical abstract). It is also possible to integrate short





videos into the slide if they are useful for documenting or clarifying the presented content. The time available on stage to present the work is 3 minutes (additional time for only one question from the audience). For slide submission, please refer to the instructions already provided for oral contributions (see above).
